

Microphones for Recording Pre-recorded Messages when using Cheetah Power Seller with Speedy Dialer Pro Hardware

When you reach an answering machine or voicemail, you may click a button on the Cheetah screen to leave a pre-recorded message, saving you from having to say the same thing over and over. Speedy Dialer Pro requires that you use either an Analog (3.5mm) Microphone or a USB Microphone to make your pre-recorded messages.
